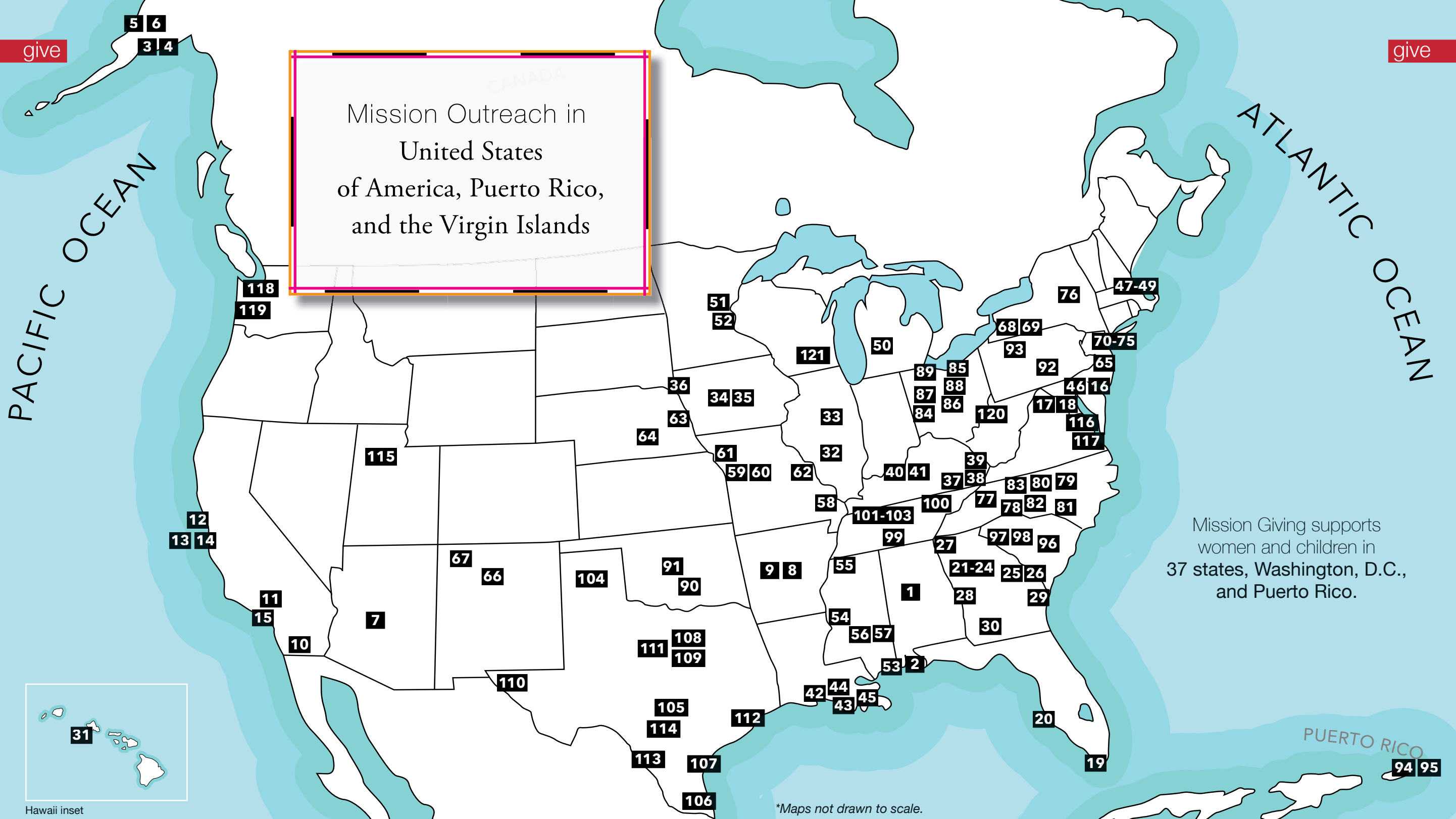

Poultry production small enterprise project offering job training and employment opportunities, nutrition and enhanced food security for women and youth in Mozambique. Maputo, Mozambique
